An exciting project to reduce waste, encourage re-use and save money has now opened in Abergavenny.

Thanks to funding from Welsh Government and working in partnership with Monmouthshire County Council, we have launched Benthyg-y-Fenni, your local "Library of Things" (Benthyg is the Welsh word for to lend or to borrow).

The aim of Benthyg-y-Fenni is to allow people to:

- borrow things they need but don't own, at low cost, saving money and space in their homes
- donate DIY items which are needed, contributing to national waste reduction targets
- meet to share knowledge and skills with each other, increasing community resilience

We aim to make it as easy to borrow

small DIY tools for those home jobs, as it is to take a book out of the library. All items will be offered out for loan at very reasonable rates and for a rental period of up to a week.

By logging into the Benthyg website, you will be able to browse online and choose what items to borrow – ranging from wheelbarrows to tents, from party crockery to pressure washers, drills, angle grinders and much more. You will be able to pick the item up from a portacabin situated in the grounds of the Abergavenny Community Centre. The website address is: monmouthshire. benthyg.cymru

A local group has been set up to get Benthyg-y-Fenni going, and we are now busy taking delivery of the items which will be loaned out, getting the venue ready with shelving and taking pictures of the



loan items and putting them on the website.

As a company, we take our responsibilities to protect the environment seriously. This is why we have been developing plans to protect the quality of the water in the river Usk. Our research, with Natural Resources Wales, shows that our assets (i.e. our treatment works, Combined Storm Overflows or CSOs) are responsible for 21%-23% of the phosphates in the river Usk, with CSOs only responsible for 1%. The remainder, is caused by other factors such as rural land use and animal faeces, urban surface water drainage, misconnected drains, as well as private septic tanks.

Our assets play a key role in protecting the local community from flooding and we cannot simply remove CSOs as this would cause significant disruption. However, we understand that this is an important matter for local residents and we are committed to playing our part to reducing our impact on the river Usk.

he last month has been a little quieter than on average for this time of year, people have still been getting out but it seems preparing well for the conditions and environment.

We were put on stand by to assist with a fallen climber in the St Arvans area, however the Fire and Rescue Service plus one of our sister teams were able to deal with it. This month our training has been focused on search theory, something that is a mix of science, maths and the dark arts. Searching techniques is something we practice quite a lot, but what we have been looking at is how best

to accurately measure the extent of an area we have searched.

This is not as easy as one would expect. It is not as simple as recording a GPS track of a group's route through an area. We also have to consider the weather, the terrain, our searchers' visible range when out, plus much more. Our search managers compile this information to deduce the 'coverage' we have achieved. For example, three searchers in a flat field with 6 inch grass on a sunny day will have a much higher 'coverage' than the same three searchers on a rocky uphill area in torrential rain with their hoods up, fighting through 5 foot bracken!

Though it might not be super exciting training, it is crucially important. How well an area has been covered so far in a search, influences future decisions on that same search.

We will cover some of this in future articles. If you would like to hear two of our most experienced team members talk about this and other stories from their time in the team, they have recently recorded a podcast with Trekkit, one of our biggest supporters. HO-HO-HOP ON BOARd for free weekend bus travel on the approach to Christmas



the most wonderful time of the year... to catch a bus! Monmouthshire shoppers and commuters are being encouraged to use public transport to help the county address the climate emergency. As an extra incentive and in time for Christmas, Monmouthshire **County Council has confirmed** that all weekend bus journeys within the county will be free to all users every weekend in December.

Passengers will be able to use this free offer, funded by Welsh Government, for any journey that has a start point and end point within Monmouthshire. It's hoped this will encourage Christmas shoppers and commuters to use

the bus to do a spot of Christmas shopping, visiting friends and relatives, or simply getting to work. It's also a great way to travel to get to a train station for trips further afield.

Councillor Catrin Maby, Cabinet Member for Climate Change and the Environment, said: "We're so pleased to have secured Welsh Government funding to help encourage residents to use the county's buses more. Every weekend in December on the approach to Christmas you'll be able to hop on to any service for a journey between two locations in Monmouthshire and not have

work? Cllr. Catrin Maby "Monmouthshire County Council have introduced electric buses into the fleet on some routes in the county, and we're working to

build upon this. If you're able to, I would encourage everyone to take advantage of this fantastic scheme, which starts on Saturday 3rd December and runs until the end of December, It's the perfect excuse to leave the car at home."

The free weekend bus travel comes in addition to free parking in council owned car parks every weekend in December, which has run for the previous two years to help support local businesses and encourage more people to shop within Monmouthshire. It is being offered again this year from Saturday 3rd December for those who are not able to travel by bus. Council car parks in the scheme are in Abergavenny, Chepstow and Monmouth (there are already free car parks in other locations in the county's other towns).

Fake it, till you wake it

been listening to the album those lyrics are taken from for nigh on 40 years, but it was only recently that it made sense to write them on a post-it note and tack it to the bottom of my computer screen.

It was near the beginning of my journey as a wellbeing coach and trainer, and even though I'd been getting fantastic results with individuals and groups alike, I couldn't shake the notion that I was a bit of a fraud: unqualified; making it up as I went along; soon to be found out... and possibly even stopped.

This feeling is so common in us humans that in 1978 it

was given a label—"Imposter Syndrome"—and in 2005, its very own Wikipedia page. I'm willing to bet that you've experienced it too: that debilitating sense that what people see and associate with your achievements is just a façade, and at any moment someone's going to see through it and discover that the "real you" is pretty clueless; deserving of zero credit for any of your successes in life, all of which have actually just been a series of flukes!

The reason this is all ringing true for you is because it is true! Except... for one crucial detail: that inadequate "real you" you're trying to hide from the world is no more real than the façade you're using to hide it. Neither of

them are deserving of *any* credit because they're both completely made up! They're thoughts, being believed, and nothing more.

On the post-it note tacked to my display, the word I've underlined in those lyrics is "appear", for what this statement is pointing to is the nature of experience itself; the immensely powerful principle of thought, that can create anything—even an identity—and then pass it off as gospel.

For as long as we believe our selves to be *any* of these illusory thought-creations, we *will* feel an imposter. Because they will shape-shift before our very eyes: fix one inadequacy and another will arise in its place. It's a game of ego whack-a-mole and it can't be won.

When it no longer makes sense to continue 'faking it' in order to protect what we have now seen to be just another façade, not only does it free up huge amounts of time and energy, but it wakes us up to who we *really* are, beneath all of our busyminded, human insecurities: creativity, authenticity, wisdom, oneness manifest – a unique expression of life-energy itself.

Imposter syndrome is a gift. It's an invitation, from life, to turn away from everything you're not, and embrace the perfection of who you are.







Before the Crawshays helped to create the biggest town in Wales, Merthyr Tydfil was a farming community whose future lay in its hidden mineral wealth. Helen Morgan from Abergavenny Local History Society reports

he first tribes probably began arriving here thousands of years ago. From Neolithic tools and Bronze Age burial cairns to the remains of Roman roads, the history of Merthyr can be found in the landscape.

The Bronze Age dagger from Cefn Cilsanws is the earliest metal artefact discovered in the Merthyr Valley. It was found in 1908 alongside human remains — clearly an important person to have been buried in such a prominent position. The dagger itself was never used as a tool, is dated at about 1600 BC and presumed to be a status item.

Moreover, it is unusual for this area, being an artefact more commonly found in Wessex. That person's descendants became known as the Silures who built Iron Age hillforts and put up a strong fight against Roman invaders in the first century. So much so that the Romans built an auxiliary fortress at Penydarren overlooking the Taff where they discarded plenty of pottery for posterity to find.

The Romans also left their language, much of which was absorbed into the Welsh vocabulary, and they introduced Christianity to Wales. Metal, however, is key to Merthyr's story. Before the invention of the cokefuelled furnace that would transform Britain in the 18th and 19th centuries, several tons of timber were needed every day to fuel a single blast furnace.



In the 16th century a fuel shortage in south-east England led to Parliament banning new iron furnaces there. This resulted in several ironmasters

heading to the upper Taff valley, attracted by its ancient forests, iron ore and fast flowing rivers. Several charcoal-fuelled furnaces were established here at this time at Troedyrhiw, Pentrebach, Heolgerrig and Pontygwaith (later Edwardsville). It is claimed that the furnace at Pontygwaith was started in 1583 by Anthony Morley, a Sussex Ironmaster, and taken over by the Lewis family.

During the Civil War it produced arms for the Royalists and was partially destroyed by the Roundheads. As well as a watercolour painting of the works, painted from memory, slag, musket balls and iron waste remain as evidence of its existence.






