wen Lewis has been campaigning to save the day centre based in Tudor Street in Abergavenny since the end of 2022. The building closed at the beginning of the pandemic and has remained closed ever since. Here he explains to us about his campaign to keep it open and functioning as a space for vulnerable members of the community.

"I worked at the centre throughout the 2010s, for a scheme called Mv Day My Life. We supported adults with learning difficulties and mental health issues in individual and group activities. One of the most important aspects of this was the person-centred approach - it was all self-chosen by the service-users themselves. Some of the activities were based within the building, others out in the community, but Tudor Street was the base from where we could develop and

organise the activities and events for the vulnerable adults that we supported. We also assisted them to get jobs, both paid and voluntary.

In November, I was informed that

Monmouthshire County Council was

to sell the building. I immediately contacted everyone I could think of to voice my concerns. I set up an online petition (which at the time of writing has almost 1,000 signatures) and organised a protest outside the building to help give the vulnerable adults a chance to raise their voices and have them heard. Through talking to them, I found out that too many of them had not been sufficiently supported through the pandemic or when coming out of it.

Our protest managed to make the council call in their initial decision. I have since been attending scrutiny meetings, where I have learned that the decision to close Tudor Street day centre ought to have been a full

cabinet decision. This was not the way the decision had been reached. in spite of overwhelmingly strong opinions in favour of not selling it.

COMMUNITY

There is an ongoing review into the My Day My Life Scheme, however, anecdotally I am told by many service-users that they have not been party to a review, and those that have find it lacking in scope and ability to identify the type of service that is needed.

I have pitched to the council a new scheme for the Tudor Street building. entitled The Gathering - a place that could provide activities, education, safety and wellbeing for everyone in the community, maintaining a focus on the most vulnerable adults. This idea has so far proven very popular and we await the outcome of the review in order to be able to discuss it more thoroughly as a proposal.

Whatever the outcome is, I feel strongly that the building needs to remain dedicated to helping the most vulnerable people of our community. There are no other places in Abergavenny that could provide such a good selection of opportunities, with appropriate disability access and facilities."

Your friendly, neigbourhood Mountain Rescue



ince our last article, the team has had three callouts all over our patch. Starting in early February we had two back-to-back callouts over a weekend. Both were very similar as they were concerning walkers who had gotten lost and needed our assistance to get off the mountains. The first was near the Grwyne Fawr Reservoir and the second was near the summit of Y Glas in the Northern Black Mountains. In both situations, the individuals were found quickly by team members, were able to be walked off, and then returned to their cars.

In mid-February the team was contacted by Gwent police due to reports that someone was injured in the front face of the Blorenge, the team was deployed and came across a group of three young men, one of which had a severe lower leg injury after taking a tumble. All

three of the lads were warmed up. and medical aid was given to the young man who was hurt. He was helped onto a stretcher and then carried around the hill to waiting paramedics and ambulance for onward transport to the hospital. We wish him a full recovery.

The team has also been out and about training this month. We have been doing medical training, to make sure our skills are up to scratch and we are prepared for anything we could come across on a callout. We have also been up on the Llangattock Crags practicing search techniques and rope rescue

Hopefully, we will see you at the end of March on the 3 peaks walk around Abergavenny. If you are on the walk then do come and say hi to the team who will be at all the checkpoints.

et's commit to being better listeners. Imagine you're having a conversation with someone. Here's a simple question: what is it you're listening to?

It's their voice, right? That's how communication works: essentially one person makes noises that are understood by the other, so that's what we're listening to.

Is it, though? What about our own thoughts? How much are we listening to those, instead? For example, weighing up what they're saying against what we know, listening in order to agree or disagree; being reminded of a similar thing that happened to us, that's too good not to share; holding on to a good idea we have, about how to respond; making judgements about how they are, or how we are, while they're talking; guessing what they're going to say next and skipping to the end to save time; or just blatantly being lost in thought and not listening at all... There are so many ways for our attention to get sidelined by our own minds, it's amazing we hear anything at all!

So what's the answer? Try really hard to pay attention? Parse their language for expressions of logic, or emotion, matching our responses accordingly, with reflection, empathy or counsel?

You can certainly try, and it may make you a better listener in the short term, but boy is it a lot of hard work and here's the kicker - all of that is giving you *more* to think about, generating more content in your mind, when we've established you're supposed to be listening to

So here's an idea. How about doing nothing? Why not listen to them as you might listen to a piece of music? Just let their words wash over you and experience them without agenda, analysis or judgement. Give another the gift of being fully present with them in this way and you'll both reap the rewards: they will feel they have the space to speak openly and you'll get to really hear what they're saying, beyond the words.

Now, we've been taught that listening should be hard work, so it's inevitable that your mind will have a lot to say about this and continue with its incessant voice-over at first... but the more you observe what it's up to and gently dismiss its unhelpful commentary as getting in the way of listening, you'll see a change. It's like listening with your heart, instead of your head.

I'll concede I was nervous when I first tried this myself, for it seems alien, potentially even rude, but the very first time I did—at a conference, advising someone

about career change—I was completely blown away by what came to mind to share with them, when the time arrived... as were

Because when we really listen. having taken our own conditioned thinking out of the equation, we instantly experience a connection to something much bigger; something that incorporates the person we're talking to and everything they're saying. Call it wisdom, or intuition, God, life energy, presence, the Now—really, call it whatever you like—but it's an endlessly creative source, it's beautifully contextual to every situation we encounter and it feels really good whenever we relax into it.

So why not give 'creative listening' a go and see what happens? It requires literally no effort on your part, and you'll be amazed by the results. What have you got to lose?







Donetsk in South-East Ukraine is Russian-speaking now but, when it was established 160 years ago, Welsh was widely spoken on its streets and in the workplace. Helen Morgan from Abergavenny Local History Society reports.

his frontline metropolis was established by pioneering Welshmen whose skills, learned in the valleys of South Wales, transformed an empty plain into an industrial powerhouse. The city that took its original name, Hughesovska, from the Welshman who led its genesis, went on to produce railways and armoured plating for Tsar Alexander II's fleet.

The 1870s were economically hard in Wales and David Cartwright's great grandparents were among many who were drawn to a better life. They left the terraced streets of

Dowlais and followed John Hughes a barely literate iron maker from Merthyr to Ukraine in search of adventure and a life of affluence. While researching his family history, Cartwright discovered how the exploits of the city's intrepid and resourceful Welsh founders brought wealth and prosperity to the region. Within two years of arriving in Hughesovska, they had built eight blast furnaces followed by collieries, mines, brickworks and railway lines. They were joined by their families who made the lengthy journey from the Valleys via the Black Sea. This led to schools, a hospital, bath houses, tea rooms,

fire brigade and places of worship being built for the Welsh-speaking migrants. However, the decisions they made also sowed the seeds of the social, political and ethnic divisions that would later tear Ukraine apart. Instead of recruiting the local peasantry as unskilled labour, Hughes chose to employ labourers from across the Russian empire. This had repercussions in both 20th and 21st centuries. While many Ukrainians resenting the Russian presence had welcomed the Nazi invasion in 1941, the Russians defended their city to the death. That blood debt probably goes a long way to explain Vladimir Putin's military support for this Russian-speaking region. Nine years ago, Russianbacked forces were welcomed into the city, and it became the fulcrum of the invasion of the rest of Southern Ukraine a year ago. Formerly known as the City of a Million Roses, it has become the city of a million bombs and bullets feeding the Russian forces, says Cartwright whose grandfather was among the last to leave during the Bolshevik Revolution in 1917.






