une has always been a notable month for me; a month of beautiful holidays over the years, many years in Kalkan, Turkey – memories of beautiful blues seas, sunshine, discovery and enjoying evening sunsets sat in roof top restaurants serving delicious Persian and Mediterranean food.

It has been a month of sadness; the month my father died 28 years ago, passing away a few days before Father's Day.

It has been a month of change: in June 2020 we were permitted to start carrying out viewings on empty properties and the pent up demand for viewings was huge – the moment it was announced that we could start to take potential buvers around empty properties the 'phones rang off the hook. I recall we launched to the market a small cottage, with a lovely garden backing onto the canal. The cottage generated 494 enquiries. We had to give the cottage its own e-mail address to avoid the main office e-mail address being deluged with enquiries, we prepared spreadsheets of all telephone calls and e-mails and filtered them down to viewings.

From a business perspective, June has always been a 'middle of the road' month; often people without children go away on holiday beating the business of the school holidays and enjoying warm and pleasant temperatures rather than the searing heat of July and August.

And June 2023? This year June has been a challenge. I had planned for a couple of weeks where some of the team were away on holiday; a couple of the team members were leaving and there was a gap between their last working day and the start dates of the new team members. I had a busy diary in terms of business commitments outside of the working day, workshops and conferences in London and away from the business, a couple of outdoor music concerts to enjoy.

On an emotional level, my stepson in law, diagnosed with Stage 4 bowel cancer in his early 40s, was undergoing major surgery - a circa 10 hour operation with the objective of removing all traces of the disease from his body to give him the chance of life and enjoy more years with his wife and teenage daughter. My stepdaughter is an amazing woman, standing strong as a wife and as a mother trying to be open with her daughter but not frightening her ...it is at times like this when family provide the comfort, the support, the kind words.

Being an avid planner, the diary was covered and I was prepared for working long hours for a couple of weeks, the team were all happy to step up and work additional hours, the short term pain worth it for the long term gain.

And then the curve ball came. Earlier this year, our gorgeous Welsh Springer Spaniel, Griff, was diagnosed with a deep-set prostate infection. Griff was in Langford, part of the University of Bristol Veterinary School. Griff's care was second to none. There were a couple of worrying days when he just did not seem to be improving, but after 10 days in doggy hospital he was soon back to his normal, happy and lively self.

Earlier this month, Griff didn't seem himself and went off his food. Thinking the infection had returned, we decided to contact Langford who suggested we take him in for some tests. During their investigations, the veterinary team discovered that Griff has Lymphoma. He is just 7 years old and the news was such a shock. After much discussion and research, we opted to put Griff through a chemotherapy programme. We are hoping that not only will the treatment extend his life by 6 – 8 months, he will not suffer and be his happy little self during the treatment. A wise piece of advice I received from a friend: Griff does not know he has cancer so don't treat him any differently.

Griff has just undergone the second session of chemotherapy; the first drug made him so, so poorly – he was very sick and didn't eat or drink for a couple of days, looking so pitiful.

Fortunately, this only lasted 48 hours and after wolfing down a few chicken dinners, he was up and about chasing squirrels. The second drug has taken away some of his spark and energy but other than being quiet, he seems happy.

And finally, only a trival curve ball but as if to say 'here's something else to cope with', I had a minor car accident. No one was hurt, thank goodness, just crumpled metal but I admit to being a little shaken.

It is at times like these when we appreciate how our home really is our sanctuary.; the place we retreat to, our safe space where we can shut out the outside world and take a deep breath. It's the place where we can sit and contemplate, cry and laugh, and be surrounded by familiarity and treasured belongings. Home is the stability in an unstable world, the security we crave when economic pressures threaten to upset the status quo.

And I understand why, during times of change, uncertainty and life throwing curve balls, it is so important to have somewhere to call home.

here's a growing trend for veg box schemes selling direct from farm to fork. Chloe Masefield reveals some great reasons to buy local.

At one time in our region, every village and town had a market garden, allotments and orchards, all brimming with seasonal fruit and veg. Supermarkets changed all that. But now a new generation of small-scale fruit and veg growers is helping to put local back on the menu, with Bannau Acres (bannauacres.co.uk), a slick new website that helps people find their nearest local veg box scheme or market stall.

But what's so good about buying local fruit and veg?

1. You get fresher, tastier, more nutritious food

Most fruit and veg starts to lose nutrients as soon as they're harvested and even UK-grown produce can take several days to make its way on to supermarket shelves. But for locally grown fruit and veg sold direct from farm to fork, it's a different story. Most of what you'll find in your weekly veg box will have been harvested just

the day before – and sometimes fresh that morning. And it will have been picked at the peak of ripeness – the point when it is naturally at its most flavourful and nutritious.

2. You support the shift to planetfriendly farming

The growers in the Bannau Acres network all farm regeneratively. That means they focus on restoring soil health, fixing carbon in the soil, building biodiversity, and returning more to the environment than they take out. They believe this approach is necessary to tackle the current climate and nature emergencies.

In addition, some of the farmers have taken the extra step to become certified Organic. And some are on their way to gaining Organic status. You can refine your search accordingly on the website.

And because the produce is all sold direct, there's less packaging, fewer food miles and less food waste, which all adds up to cleaner, greener, more climate-friendly farming.

3. You help build food security Currently in the UK we're overreliant on imports and global food supply chains. Empty supermarket shelves and shortages over the past few years have revealed just how fragile that system is. But by supporting local growers you play a vital part in rebuilding local food supplies, creating a fairer food system and making our communities more resilient to future food shocks.

4. You help boost the local economy

When you buy fruit and veg direct from local growers, they receive a much greater share of the profit than they would in the supermarket system. What's more, that money tends to stay local. And the more money that's spent locally, the stronger the local economy grows, which means more jobs, better facilities and more vibrant villages and towns – better for everyone.

5. Your money does good

There's a nifty bit of research by the New Economics Foundation that shows that every £1 spent on fruit and veg through box schemes or farmers' markets generates a further £3.70 in social, economic and environmental benefits – and we think that's a pretty convincing message!

July Weather Outlook

fter a June which produced some fine, dry, and at times very warm periods of weather, rekindling the seasonal 'flaming' tie-in with the month, July could well match or even surpass June. 

Stepping away from anxiety

"I've lived through some terrible things in my life, some of which actually happened."

~ Mark Twain

nxiety is a big deal, with recent statistics suggesting that around 15% of the population qualify for an anxiety 'disorder'. Of course that number pales next to the feeling of anxiety that we all experience from time to time; me too. These days, you don't have to look very far to find a lot to be anxious about!

Nobody really *likes* being anxious
— for that 15% it's debilitating — so
let's look at some simple steps you
can take to deal with it.

1. Understand where it comes from

This is the most important, and on its own, affords a fresh perspective on the experience that might just change it forever. Because, while it *looks* like your anxious feelings come from situations or people, that's technically not possible. Anxiety is not a contagious disease. It's not transmissible.

The source of anxious feelings is anxious thought. Full stop. There is no other way to experience it, which explains why some people just aren't bothered by something that might be panic-inducing in another. If anxiety came from the situation, we'd all be equally worried by it.

2. Observe what the mind is doing

I said, above, that we can find a lot to be anxious *about*, and it's helpful to realise that this process of 'finding' has nothing to do with reality, and everything to do with the mind's narrative.

When encountering *any* fluctuation in your energy, or feeling state, its first job is to label it - *Oh, I know this feeling, it's anxiety!* - then try and figure out what must be causing it, using the data it has, to do so. Sabretooth tigers haven't really been a thing for some time now, so if you're not in imminent physical danger, it looks instead to everything you've consumed in the media, or been told you *should* fear by your parents and peers... hence, the neverending list of things. Squash one, and another will pop up in its place.

The mind is a pattern-matching machine that thinks it's keeping you safe by predicting the future (badly), guessing how you're likely to *feel* in those situations (even more badly) and then getting itself in a right tizz when it realises it has zero control over any of that uncertainty. Hello, anxiety!

3. Accurately locate your safety zone

What are we to do, then? Stop thinking? Try only thinking non-anxious thoughts? (I'm betting you've tried both of those – they don't really work, do they?)

No, it's much easier than that. We just leave it be. We see its nature - a harmless script from the computer mind, that is *not* who we are - and

we stop listening to it. Stripped of its power, it settles, naturally; a process encapsulated beautifully in the words of Sri Yukteshwar, the 19th Century Yogi, who said, "An ignored quest quickly leaves."

When the focus of our attention is no longer on a load of useless mindrubbish, there's really only one place it *can* be: here and now. *This* is your safety zone, and it's where you've been built to thrive. Clear-minded and fully present, you can - and do! - handle *whatever* comes your way. It's how we're designed, all of us!

Even if the mind strikes lucky and perfectly predicts a terrible scenario you must endure... when you're in the thick of it, truly present and dealing with it, all future uncertainty has been removed, and along with it, any anxiety. That's when you hear yourself saying, sheepishly, "Oh it wasn't half as bad as I'd expected."

Armed with this knowledge, you are free to skip the anxious thinking and just live your life, one moment at a time.

As a company, we take our responsibilities to protect the environment seriously. This is why we have been developing plans to protect the quality of the water in our rivers.

Our research with Natural Resources Wales shows that our assets (i.e. our treatment works, Combined Storm Overflows or CSOs) are responsible for around 21% of the phosphates in the river Usk, with CSOs only responsible for 1%. The remainder, is caused by other factors such as rural land use and animal facees, urban surface water drainage, misconnected drains, as well as private septic tanks.

We have permits in place at our wastewater treatment works to protect the river. These permits are set by our environmental regulators and can be changed by them when needed, to reflect the changing needs of the river, or when new evidence is found. When this happens, we work with our regulators to improve and upgrade our treatment works.

Sermons in Stone

The man who founded the campaign to save redundant places of worship was a local boy of humble origins who went far. Helen Morgan from Abergavenny Local History Society reports.

vor Thomas was born in Cwmbran in 1905 into a working class family. His father's job was in the brickworks and his mother was a domestic servant. He was, however, bright enough to go to West Monmouthshire school in Pontypool from where he won a scholarship to Oxford University, graduating with a first-class degree.

He went on to become a distinguished journalist and prolific author before embarking on a short-lived career as a Labour MP in 1942. He was also a layman of the Church of England — despite having been brought up as a strict Baptist — and changed his name to Bulmer-Thomas in 1952 after marrying Margaret Bulmer, scion of the cider dynasty.

Most outstandingly he was the inspiration behind the Friends of Friendless Churches supported by John Betjeman, TS Eliot and others campaigning to save historic buildings. Established on

3rd July 1957 in Committee Room 13 of the House of Commons, they fought for a formal churchand-state-led structure to protect redundant chapels and churches as "sermons in stone".

Of the many hopeless or lost causes that he championed were quite a number in south-east Wales including St Mary's in Llanfair Kilgeddin. Its medieval fabric survives in its chancel roof, stained glass and font. Its chancel screen is 15th century and quoins in the west gable are dated 1634 and 1664.

Within the transept is a symphonic series of colourful sgraffito panels from the Arts & Crafts period. They are the work of John Dando Sedding who applied five differently coloured plaster layers to the wall, each at a different depth, and left them to dry over night. The next day fresh plaster was applied that was then cut away to reveal the desired colours.

In 1982, however, the church was condemned as unsafe. It was then declared redundant. The diocese proposed to raze it to the ground — until Bulmer-Thomas and the Friends, supported by the Victorian Society came to the rescue.

Cadw funded essential repairs making St Mary's wind and watertight. The church is now listed Grade I and is friendless no more. The church is normally locked but directions to find the key are in the porch. The churchyard, too, is of interest with gravestones belonging to the Crawshays, some of whom lived near by.




