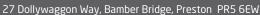

bergavenny Concertgoers Club is close to its eightieth birthday having been founded during the last years of the Second World War. More recently it resumed events after an enforced break due to Covid with a trial run in May 2023 to see who was interested, and forty came with us to Stratford-on-Avon for a most stimulating performance of Shakespeare's 'As You Like It' starring Geraldine James as well as many other well-known actors.

Encouraged by this show of support the club settled on three events for this Autumn, all well attended: a symphony concert in Birmingham featuring the acclaimed organist Thomas Trotter; an October concert by the Ukraine Symphony Orchestra in Hoddinott Hall; and in November a performance of John Mortimer's play 'A Voyage Round my Father' in Malvern's fine theatre. Events scheduled for 2024 include Somerset Maughan's play 'The Circle' in Bath's Theatre Royal; Hereford Cathedral for Rachmaninoff's 'Vespers'; Cardiff's Millennium Centre for Mozart's 'Cosi Fan Tutte' and Puccini's 'Il Triticco': orchestral concerts in Cardiff's Hoddinott Hall; Stratfordupon-Avon for Shakespeare.

The club is a locally-based nonprofit-making association of over one hundred members open to all interested in attending arts-related events; especially concerts, theatre, and opera. It has been contributing to Abergavenny's cultural life for almost eight decades and is run by a small volunteer committee. There's a small membership subscription of £10 a year, and the cost of events covers the ticket price and the coach fare including a tip for the driver.

wo ancient Welsh traditions continue to be celebrated in Abergavenny. Why not come and join in? All collections will be donated to Abergavenny Food Bank. Last year we were able to present a cheque for £500 collected over these two days.

Hen Galan (the Old New Year) and the Mari Lwyd

Hen Galan or the Old New Year gets its name from the change, in 1752, to the calendar: the old, Julian Calendar (named after Julius Caesar) being replaced by the Gregorian Calendar (named after Pope Gregory XIII). Not everyone was happy with this change, which happened following September 2nd 1752 - the next day was September 14th. Many parts of Wales stuck with the old calendar and even today, in one valley in Pembrokeshire, there is an unbroken tradition of celebrating New Year's Day, or Dydd Calan, on January 13th. This date is now increasingly being celebrated

as a Welsh New Year along with traditional folk customs such as Mari Lwyd and Plygain services.

On January 13th 2024, the procession of the Mari Lwyd, with its traditional Welsh singing, that was once popular in Abergavenny and throughout Gwent and Glamorgan, returns once again, jointly organised by Cymreigyddion y Fenni and Merched y Wawr.

The Mari Lwyd timetable for January 13th 2024 will be as follows:

3.30pm The Chapel Cafe and Gallery, Market Street followed by The Angel Hotel, The King's Head, The Hen and Chicks, The Kings Arms and The Grofield, arriving at Holy Trinity Church Hall, Baker Street by 6:30 for supper at 7.00pm

Anyone who would like to come for supper must email Jill Green – jill. keith@btinternet.com by Wednesday, January 10th, stating whether they require a vegetarian meal. The cost of the supper will be £12.

Y Plygain

On Sunday, January 14th, at 6pm the traditional Plygain service will be celebrated at Holy Trinity Church. It is a traditional Welsh language Church service and not a concert and all are welcome to attend and experience the occasion.

Y Plygain was originally a Welsh Christmas service held in Church between 3am and 6am on Christmas morning. Its popularity, first recorded in a 13th century Welsh manuscript, declined during the Victorian era but continued in a few places. The 21st century has seen a strong revival of this tradition including here in Abergavenny, where the service has been held annually, apart from lockdown, since 2015.

For this service Churches were traditionally lit by candlelight. The vicar introduces the service with prayer and a reading from Scripture. Three carols are sung by the congregation but the rest of the carols are sung by individuals or small groups. Plygain carols are unusual as they

frequently tell the whole story of Christ from His birth to His crucifixion and are firmly rooted in Scripture.

If you wish to participate and sing a Plygain carol, please contact Ruth Roberts (*1ruthroberts@gmail.com*), so that no carol is repeated. This is one of the few restrictions passed down through the centuries.

Y Plygain will be followed by a finger 'Bring and Share' supper in the Church Hall to which all the congregation are invited. The hall will be open prior to the service for your food contributions.

A retiring collection will be made after the service and again this will be donated to the local Food Bank.

We look forward to seeing you at either or both events.

For the Coulis

- 1 punnet raspberries
- 2tbsp icing sugar

Preheat oven 160 degrees celcius/140 Fan/gas mark 3 and line the base of a swiss roll tin 33cm x 23cm with parchment paper

Whisk your egg whites until Lethey hold soft peaks and the mixture stays in the bowl if turned upside down (be careful not to overbeat as this causes the eggs to collapse.)

Whisk in your caster sugar about a tablespoon at a time. whisking all the time until all the sugar has been added and the mixture is stiff and glossy. Beat in the cornflour and lemon juice

Spoon into the prepared **a**tin, spreading the meringue evenly. Bake for 25 minutes until a light golden crust forms. Remove from the oven and cool in the tin for approximately 5 minutes

Cut a piece of greaseproof paper that is slightly larger than the baking tin and lightly dust it with icing sugar. Gently invert the meringue on to the paper. Remove the tin, leaving the parchment paper on the meringue until completely cold

Make the filling by melting the chocolate in a small bowl over a pan of simmering water, making sure the water does not touch the bottom of the bowl. When the chocolate has melted remove from the heat and cool

Whip the cream and vanilla bean paste until the cream just holds its shape. Gently fold in the cooled chocolate

Remove the parchment paper from the meringue and spread over the cream mixture evenly. Scatter over the hazelnuts and raspberries. Using the paper underneath the meringue to help, roll up the meringue from the short edge. Some cracking may appear but this adds to the log effect. Gently place on a serving dish and dust with icing sugar

Make the coulis by blending •the raspberries and icing sugar until smooth. Sieve into a jug and drizzle a little over the log, leaving the remainder to serve.

henever I start work with a new group or an individual, there's an underlying, unwritten assumption that what we're working towards is 'happiness,' for want of a better word. A nicer experience than the one they're currently having, be that in the workplace, at home, or just within themselves. Peace of mind, if you like.

Sometimes that assumption gets dragged out into the light, as happened recently when a client of mine expressed their frustration at the persistence of strong, unwanted emotions. "I don't get it! Why am I so angry all the time, it just seems so pointless?!" they exclaimed, with obvious exasperation.

If you've ever been harassed by unwelcome feelings such as worry, sadness, irritability, grief, loneliness, jealousy, self-doubt or despair, you'll probably empathise. Nobody really likes these emotions, and it's only natural to want rid of them, especially if they're a regular fixture in your life.

And it seems, almost intuitively, that the answer is surely to figure out why they're happening; to dig into the distant, or recent past to identify and understand our triggers, so that we can work on our responses to them, or try and avoid them altogether.

Reflecting on my client's predicament however, I found myself musing out loud, furnishing them with a choice, in the form of a question it feels too juicy for us not to explore further, here. It was this:

"Do you want to know why, or do you want to be happy?"

Again, it seems like the first should lead to the second (which is why, after some hand-wringing, they replied, "I want both!") but from working with hundreds of humans over the years, it's become apparent to me that it's actually one or the other. You can't have both.

The simple reason behind this is that the mind is the source of our various discomforts, not the solution to them. It could furnish you with the perfect answer as to why you feel

the way you do — thereby offering temporary relief by shutting up for a while — only to change its mind moments later, deciding no, that's not it, or simply creating another unanswerable question to keep itself occupied, terrorising you, in the process. For as long as you reward it with attention, it will never stop.

Peace of mind, therefore is a choice. A fork in the road we arrive at. often in mid-life, where we get to definitively take one path over the other: do I want to continue dancing to the tune of the mind and its insatiable demands, or do I want to be happy?

Either answer is perfectly fine, but know this: commit, you must. The mechanics of the human experience are such that it only works one way and the path to contentment means divorce from the mind's chatter. Seeing through its essentially meaningless commentary means no longer turning to it for advice, and if you regularly enter into a dialogue with it, you're resigning yourself to living much of your life away from the place that life is actually happening: the present moment.

My client, having identified that years of trawling through the mind's lifeless data for answers is what had led them to seek help from me in the first place, resolved to let go of that strategy, and, in doing so, committed to happiness.


It's only fair that you should have the same opportunity, so right here, right now, I'm inviting you to ponder that same question, too.



On His Doorstep

Far From the Madding Crowd opened a new chapter in Thomas Hardy's life. Helen Morgan from Abergavenny Local History Society reports.

he novel was such a success that he was able to relinquish his day job as an architect and turn to building a house of his own.

He bought the site of a former toll house on the outskirts of Dorchester, known as (Henry) Mack's Gate. The house he designed became known as Max Gate, a deliberate pun.

His was a family of builders and, as they cleared the site, they found Roman relics and even a neolithic stone.

First he built a simple redbrick two-up, two-down house in 1885. Then, with his continued success as a novelist and growing need for more rooms he extended the Queen Anne style house. It was here that he wrote Tess of the d'Urbervilles, basing the main character in part on one of the women who appeared before him in his role as magistrate in the Shire Hall courtroom.

Hardy continued to live and continue his writing at Max Gate until his death in 1928. While he knew about the Roman relics, what he never realised was that he

had built his house on one side of a neolithic stone circle.

This came to light in 1987 during digging ahead of the Dorchester bypass being built. The other half circle is the garden in front of the house. His study is now at Dorset County Museum whose galleries cover 250 million years of history. Highlights include: the skull of a pliosaur, one of the largest sea monsters ever unearthed; a pair of skeletons from Maiden Castle: Roman mosaic floors that visitors can walk on: William Hogarth's portrait of Thomas Coombes aged 108; and an entire room of Hardy material.

Shire Hall, the 18th-century courthouse on the High Street where Judge Jeffries and Hardy sat in judgment at different times, is also open to the public. It is now a museum that brings to life more than 200 years of justice and injustice. Newly refurbished to allow access to all, it offers the opportunity to follow in the footsteps of men and woman who sat in its primitive Georgian cells, "more enlightened" Victorian cells and the room that held the six agricultural workers who became the Tolpuddle "Martyrs" in the 1830s before being tried and deported to Australia.

Dorchester is part of a fourday visit to Dorset next May. For details please go to abergavennylocalhistorysociety.org. uk . Lectures return in January.




