It was planted around 12 years ago, and has matured into a place of beauty, wildlife and wellbeing. It is managed by a small team of volunteers, but all member of the community are very welcome to come and enjoy the orchard,

and in summer to come and pick and enjoy the fruit, whilst leaving enough fruit for others to enjoy.

Most recently, the traditional wassail celebration has been held, with around 200 people attending. The procession around the orchard was led by the orchard's Green Man puppet, made by Susan Holder and Tom Bramley. The procession was followed by a traditional wassail ceremony, led by Jeff Davies, and children were invited to places pieces of toast soaked in cider, in the branches of the apple trees, to please the orchard spirits! Cider and apple juice pressed from orchard apples, and apple cake, was then enjoyed by everyone present, and as the evening drew in the braziers and candles were lit to make the orchard look even more magical than usual.

There are activities throughout the year for people to enjoy and celebrate the changing seasons. There will be a Spring Blossom Picnic on Bank Holiday Monday 6th May, with lots of chidren's activities associated with nature, and lots of picnicking! We have our annual AGM in the orchard on 21st July, accompanied by a communal picnic. In July and August we will be undertaking some traditional haymaking, and in autumn we will be running our popular apple pressing days at the Community Centre. Everyone is very welcome to attend. We also hold monthly maintenance days, when we undertake various tasks, and again everyone is very welcome to pop along. #### New Expressive Arts Opportunities for Young People in Abergavenny.



re you ages 11 to 19 and interested in Theatre? Creative Futures is hosting weekly Youth Theatre workshops in Abergavenny. The term-time and holiday programmes will consist of a series of dynamic sessions led by professional theatre practitioners, exploring different modes of self-expression and enabling you to share your stories and experiences.

Sessions will be open to all and free of charge. The Creative Futures Project is committed to opening the power of theatre to as many young people as possible giving everyone the chance to express themselves and tell their story. Sessions will be guided by young people themselves, based on issues and experiences that resonate with them.

Incorporating writing, physical theatre, and numerous other theatrical skills, the Creative

Futures Project is working to establish a permanent Monmouthshire Youth Theatre, based in Abergavenny, and supporting other youth theatre organisations throughout the county. Through opening up more local expressive arts opportunities to young people, creating multidisciplinary performance, growing their practice, and giving platform for further study and work in theatre, we will build an inspiring and dynamic theatre culture for our young people here in Abergavenny.

The project aims to inspire conversation amongst young people and to develop a genuinely engaging programme based upon the issues that emerge as the most current and important to them.

Funded by the UK Shared Prosperity Fund, Creative Futures is a collaboration between The Borough Theatre, Dance Blast,

Melville Centre for the Arts and Monmouthshire Youth Services. Through collaboration, shared knowledge, expertise, and resources, we will build a stronger network that supports young people in their journeys of selfexpression.

Sessions will take place at Melville Centre for the Arts each Saturday through term-time, with the Half Term programme running for 3 days of the holiday. Easter Programme to be announced soon!





## Moving We Matters

efore I was a yoga teacher, I worked with patients with complex or palliative care needs, at home and in the community. It was humbling work.

When I began teaching, I found students in their eighties doing headstands, but in my 'day job', I had patients in their thirties needing opiates to tie their shoes. Keeping people mobile and confident in their body's resilience and adaptability is my main motivation.

It saddens me that people resign themselves to a certain level of inflexibility, immobility, or even pain as aging occurs. None of this need be tolerable, or even inevitable. Gentle exercise, based on natural movement can help with daily activities such as standing, reaching, bending down, walking, dressing, washing, and playing with children and pets.

Over the last decade, it was found that one in eight preventable deaths in England and Wales

involved a fall, especially among older people. Prioritising balance and mobility is essential in later life, not only for longevity, but for personal independence, dignity, and freedom.1

A society that prioritises speed and productivity overlooks the value and skill of those requiring more time, patience, and general 'slowness.'This negatively impacts people's self-worth, and willingness to participate or try new things.

There are studies now demonstrating how yoga and meditation can slow or reverse cognitive decline, language loss, and visuospatial impairment in susceptible populations. They further report improved executive function, mood, and sleep quality in the groups who did regular yoga and Mindfulness than in those who did other types of relaxation and memory exercises.<sup>2</sup>

Participating in group exercise classes also creates friendships which mitigate the social isolation and loneliness associated with aging. I hope to offer as widely accessible classes as possible. Gone are the days of teaching headstands - I have embraced my demographic of mostly middle aged people and older, with varying medical backgrounds - mastectomy, hysterectomy, hip and knee replacements, stroke recovery and early stages of dementia. We move slowly, modify where necessary and relax. We celebrate moving as well as we can, for as long as we can.



## *"I tried Pilates for the first time...and now I am hooked!"*

et it be known - I am not much of a mover and have always shunned the idea of exercise classes. To me they feel like lycra clad pressure cookers in which you sweat and try in vain to keep. However, one of my new year's resolutions involved trying something new this year, which happens to be Pilates. I mean, I've heard of it, but I've never really understood it, which meant the idea of attending a class filled me with dread and, well, see above.

I'd heard good things on the grapevine about KT Pilates. Kate Thomas is a professionally trained dancer, actor and APPI certified Pilates Instructor with over 15 years teaching experience of dance, movement and Pilates and teaches locally in lots of locations, with lots of classes, including one to one tuition. Unknown to many is that Kate has developed an entire library of easy to access Pilates classes available through her subscription App which costs £10 per month or £89.99 for a full year's access. Once you have signed up, you'll discover a huge variety of Pilates classes made personally by Kate from her studio based near Raglan.

I may have mentioned that I am a beginner, and I really am, so the idea of an App felt like a good starting point for me, especially as there are classes ranging from absolute beginners through to advanced. There are short classes of just 10 minutes, or longer classes of up to an hour. You can wind down in the evening with an evening stretch or take 10 minutes out of your day for an arm toning class - one of my favourites! Not only does an online class from a professional in their field give you the confidence that you're learning from somebody who knows what they're doing, but you can make your exercise fit into your day and your routine ideal if you're a busy person...and who isn't these days?



## Wales on the Map

Maps like charts are designed to guide us from place to place but they also reflect the social and political standards of their time. Helen Morgan from Abergavenny Local History Society reports.



blatant example is the early 15th-century map by the monks of Evesham Abbey, drawn at the time of the Owain Glyndwr uprising. They greatly exaggerated England on the world stage and reduced Scotland and Wales to featureless offshore islands. As the Tudor age progressed, however, cartography improved. The first map of Wales as a discrete entity was produced in 1573 as a statement of nationhood by the **Denbighshire polymath Humphrey**  Llwyd. Notably, his border of Wales stretches as far east as the River Severn, as if the Glyndwr uprising had succeeded and gives place names in Welsh, English and Latin. Then, three decades later the first atlas depicting the 13 individual counties of Wales was produced by John Speed, a renowned historian and cartographer, whose maps are still much prized, and have been copied and imitated ever since.

"In more modern times, the Cold War played its part in mapping,"

sensitive sites such as military bases, components factories and radar stations off the map. At the height of the Cold War, more than 5,000 such secret sites existed all over Britain, many in Wales. The irony was that the Soviet Union had its own maps containing all the secret stuff unavailable to the British public. "Maps are the perfect synthesis of art and science. Leading the way in Wales for decades has been the painter Iwan Bala. He is celebrated for his memorised and

imagined maps, with work ranging from a fantasy Wales drawn for a prog rock album in the 1970s to a recent advertising campaign by Brains Beer. Maps are incredibly powerful tools, for they burrow deep into our sense of identity and belonging, and can be used for both good and ill."




